



# How does Scotty's work with Hospices and pre-bereavement care providers?

## Who can Scotty's help?

Are they a parent who is serving/has served in the British Armed Forces?

Do they have children aged between 0-25?

Do they have a terminal diagnosis?

If the answer is yes to all three questions then we can help.

## What can Scotty's provide?

1:1 counselling and emotional support for children and young people.

Support for parent and carers.

Peer support and Events.

Respite Breaks.

Educational grants and resources for schools.

Cards and gifts at birthdays and Christmas.

Advocacy.



## Working collaboratively

We are here to work collaboratively with hospices to provide comprehensive support for families.

We are not here to replicate the work of other organisations but to work alongside them to provide additional benefits and long-term, ongoing support until the children are 25 years old.

## How do we work together?

- Ask your clients/patients if they have served.
- If you identify a family eligible for Scotty's support then you can help them to sign up for free Membership using [this form](#) or QR code :



- We offer online counselling and lower-level emotional support, if you feel this is appropriate you can make a referral.
- You can help a family access a Scotty's respite break by making a professionals referral.
- We offer various grants that can help a young person access extra curricular activities or other educational experiences.
- As a military charity we collaborate with a variety of other military services and organisations where families can access a raft of support including financial, housing, pensions, breaks and holidays, days out and further emotional support. We can help make referrals on the family's behalf and work with you to get them further support if needed.
- We offer a place for the families you support to be connected with other military families who will understand what they are going through and can support each other to rebuild their lives.

## FAQs

### Do you support all types of illness?

YES! We support anyone with a terminal diagnosis whether that be through Cancer, Motor Neurone Disease, Parkinson's, Dementia etc. We will offer support regardless of the time frame of life expectancy.

### Do you support serving and veteran?

YES! Anyone that has served in the British Armed Forces is eligible for our support. This includes Reservists and across all Services.

### Do you support over 18s?

YES! We support children and young people aged 0-25.

### Do you support families in all their many forms?

YES! Scotty's is not only for biological or legally adopted children. People define what family means to them, not us.
